Total Number of Establishments in NCR: 2009

The results of the 2009 Annual Survey on Philippine Business and Industries (ASPBI) revealed that Wholesale and Retail Trade had the most number of establishments with 2,604 or 23.4 percent of the total. Meanwhile, industries in the Manufacturing sector reached 2,019, or 18.2 percent, which was second in terms of number of establishments in NCR. Rounding the top three was Real Estate, Renting and Business Activities which had a total number of 1,968 or 17.7 percent of the total. *Refer to Table 1 for details*.

Real Estate, Renting and Business Activities have the most number of employed persons


The industry with the most number of employed persons was Real Estate, Renting and Business Activities with 452 thousand or 32 percent of the total, followed by Manufacturing with 203 thousand or 14 percent. Wholesale and Retail Trade industry ranked third with 163 thousand or 12 percent of the total employed persons. *Refer to Table 1 for details*.


Service Industry's Revenue sees Upward Trend


The revenue in the Service industry saw an upward trend, registering ₱8.0 billion in 1999 to ₱18.3 billion in 2009. Meanwhile, Wholesale and Retail Trade and Manufacturing industries exhibited slow growth during the early part of 2000 in terms of revenue until such increase in 2009.

Value Added by 1-digit PSIC in NCR: 2009

Financial Intermediation sector had the highest value added, having ₱3.21 billion or 22 percent of the total value added for NCR. This was closely followed by Transport, Storage and Communications with ₱2.86 billion or 20 percent. Rounding up the top three was Real Estate, Renting and Business Activities with ₱2.25 billion or 15 percent of the total value added for NCR. Refer to Table 1 for details.








